## Strategy and Objectives

There are economic challenges that reverberate throughout Egypt. Since we are located in the middle of rural and industrial areas, many people around us need our help. Our community service council, health, social and environmental sustainability committees are working hard together annually to design an implementation plan for poverty alleviation to support the national initiative endorsed by President Abdel Fattah Al-Sisi Decent life "[Haya Karima](#)", and to fulfill the needs of the surrounding environment of Delta University. We offer many services for our community to tackle poverty and provide a decent life, such as offering free healthcare services in the university dental hospital, outpatient medicine, physical therapy clinics, medical conveyers in the villages and primary schools, engaging with elementary schools, elder literacy, social and environmental awareness companies, financial aids, scholarships for low-income students, and collaboration with stakeholders who can contribute to solve our community problems.

## Awareness campaigns

We are responsible to spread awareness amongst the university community of governmental and university initiatives as well as strategic plans that aim to alleviate the burden on local communities that need it the most. Our [social sustainability committee](#) organize events, workshops, and seminars to raise awareness of initiatives related to poverty in Delta University faculties targeting staff, students and employees. For instant, faculty of Arts organized a workshop to introduce the concept of sustainable development and its close relation to the presidential initiatives "[A Decent Life](#)" on [August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022](#).

**Community Outreach**

Tackling poverty in local communities has multi-faceted dimensions and is interconnected with many other SDGs. Delta University is reaching out to assist those who are in most needs through many planned initiatives prepared annually by community services council and sustainability committees which include [anti-poverty program](#). One of those initiatives is to support and empower blind women **start up business** to sell their handicrafts to the university community in an exhibition that was held at Delta University campus on [December 24<sup>th</sup>, 2022](#). We also support blind children in elementary schools by frequently visiting them to bring joy and happiness as well as financial aid to them. Participation of Delta University students in charitable events such as the one organized on [November, 4<sup>th</sup> 2022](#) for blind school students, orphanages on [March, 27<sup>th</sup> 2022](#) and children cancer hospitals on [December 10<sup>th</sup>, 2022](#) and [May 8<sup>th</sup>, 2022](#) is our way to develop their personality into responsible citizens. These opportunities let the students understand how sustainable development is an unmet need in our community for a better future.

Providing [free healthcare services](#) in university dental hospital and clinics or even through medical conveys for citizens in villages, rural areas and industry workers are one of many pledges of Delta University board of trustees and administrative leadership toward the community in Egypt without any discrimination based on gender, nationally, or race. These services were recognized by [governmental authorities](#) and [other universities](#) through honoring [the founder and chairman](#) of Delta University board of trustees because of his contribution to local community. Also, Delta University's [student societies](#) have a great role in medical sector as they are highly active in organizing voluntary [blood donation campaigns](#) on and off campus in collaboration with Egyptian Red Crescent. Blood donation is linked to SDG 1 (No Poverty) and SDG 10 (Reduced Inequalities), as it helps in addressing health disparities and ensuring equal access to life-saving interventions for poor people.

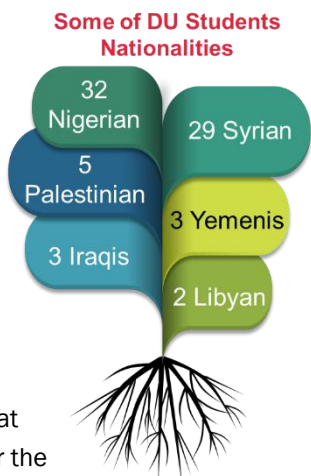
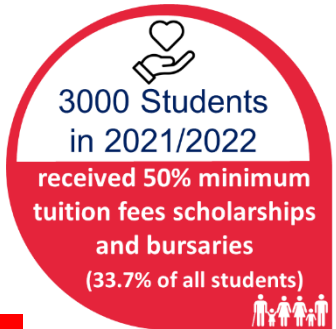
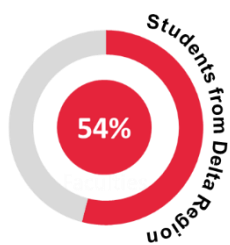

## Stewardship initiatives

**University anti-poverty program** is dedicated for low-income students hailing from national, regional and/or other international low and/or lower-middle income countries such as Syria, [Yemen](#), Libya, [Nigeria](#), etc., as defined by World Bank. We prioritize and target students coming from governorates near Delta University as we enrolled more than half of our students from Delta region in the past five years. We also consider the admission of [displaced students](#) and refugees coming from war zones such as Ukraine, Sudan and Russia. We also support and encourage the enrolment of students with [special needs](#) offering aids and guidance throughout their study journey at Delta University. President of Delta University, Prof. Yehia EIMashad offered complete scholarship to a student with cancer on [September, 2nd, 2022](#). In the category of need-based scholarship, we offer scholarships and bursaries stating from 30% to 100% fee discount based on the financial ability of the student's family that can be classified into three categories (Not Capable, Partially Capable, Special circumstances such as (father death, illness, etc.)

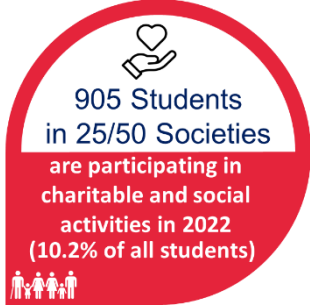

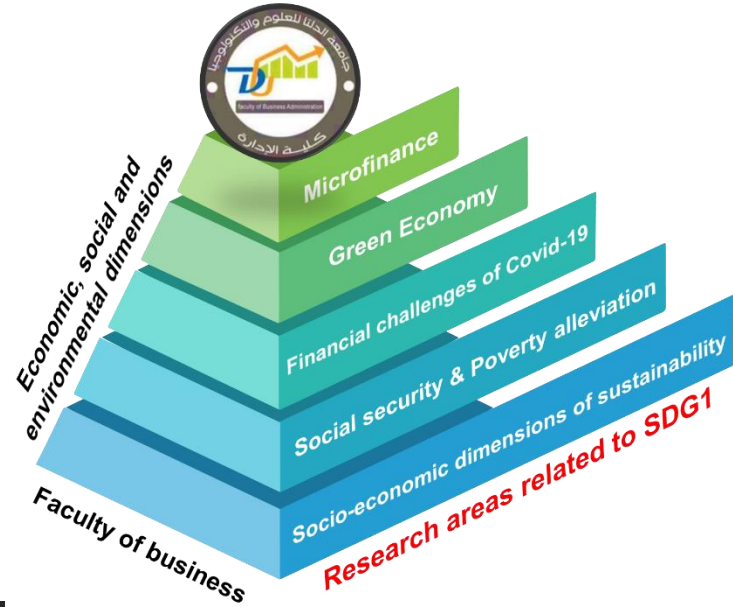

**Research**

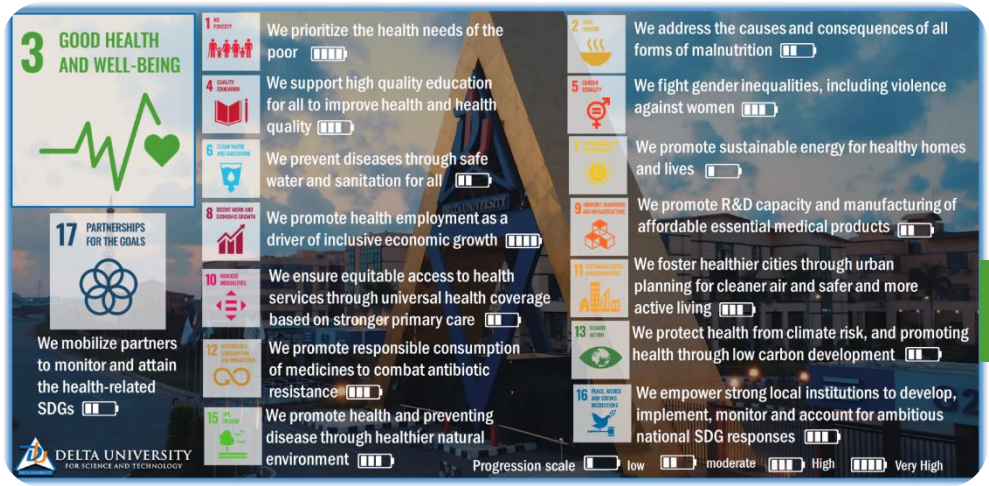

## Ensure healthy lives and promote well-being for all at all ages

### Strategy and Objectives

In line with the Egyptian government's plan to support, promote and disseminate the values and culture of human rights in the Egyptian society. Delta University is collaboratively working with other governmental institutions, civil society, and private sector in implementation of the articles of the Egyptian constitution and law regarding the protection of human rights without slightest discrimination, aiming at equal opportunities among all, [leaving no one behind](#). The **healthcare sustainability committees** at Delta University for Science and Technology are distributed among 5 different faculties with the aim of contribution to human right in good health and wellbeing. Egypt's vision 2030 includes the promotion of human right in healthcare without discrimination between men, women, children, and the elderly to achieve the principle of equal opportunities in health education, services, and work. Delta University seeks through community outreach, which include (seminars - workshops - convoys - research activities - protocols) to achieve these goals, which is evident in all the activities of the faculties related to health sector such as faculties of medicine, oral and dental medicine, physical therapy, pharmacy

In 2022 with active participation of students in medical faculties, experts, practitioners and stakeholders, more than 20 [awareness campaigns](#) and health-related conferences were organized at Delta University to build an internal knowledge society in topics related to healthcare and public health such as [Antibiotic Abuse](#), [Seasonal Influenza](#), [Diabetes and NCD's](#), [Respiratory Allergy](#), [Breast Cancer](#), [Headaches causes and treatment](#), [Autism](#), [Antibiotic Resistance](#), [Ethics in medical career](#), [Health Risk of Technology](#) and more.

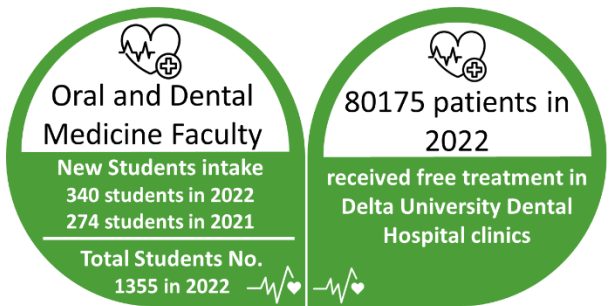

**Community Outreach**

We are reaching to our local community on or off campus to provide healthcare services, medication, education, and awareness through medical conveys in the villages such as [Al-Amal](#) and [Shoha](#), [consultations](#), [training](#), [student forums](#), [donations](#), [solidarity and support](#), treating patients in our clinics ([medicine](#), [dental](#), [physical therapy](#)).



We engage with young students from elementary and high schools and also orphanages ([Full Report](#)) by hosting them in dental hospital to prepare them for future challenges, nourish children's lifelong learning passion, raise awareness of the benefits and opportunities that higher education can bring, especially for students representing the less fortunate sections of the society.



**Stewardship initiatives**

We are provide [health services](#) for university and local communities through [dental hospital clinics](#), physical therapy [outpatient clinics](#) and [research laboratories](#), [medical outpatient clinics](#) and labs, [drug information center](#), [counselling & psychological support unit](#). We also provide free access to our [sport facilities](#) to students from other universities and school children. Our students are raising the awareness in [reproductive and sexual healthcare](#) under supervision of safe women unit in the faculty of medicine. We offer diploma certificate in clinical nutrition in both faculty of medicine and in [physical therapy](#). We provide training for nurses and others in health profession to promote interprofessionalism in healthcare sector.



[Delta Plus](#) is an advanced unit for continuous and lifelong learning in dental education. Our faculty of oral and dental medicine is accredited by [NAQAAE](#) and [Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh](#).



## Student's commitment

We encourage interdisciplinary activities between students in Health disciplines and students in other specialties by participating in a national and global competition. A joint experimental study entitled “*nature in virtual reality improves mood and reduces stress: pilot study on Delta University*” between students in architectural engineering and students in faculty of medicine was conducted. The architectural students seek to assess the impact of their [sustainable park design](#) on health of volunteers exposed to [virtual reality](#). The students participated in [Hackathon competition](#) which was organized by the ministry of higher education & research and they qualified to the final round of the competition. Medical students at Delta University also participate in health conferences such as [IFMSA-Egypt](#) and [Africa Health Excon](#). We prepare them for labor market in health profession by participating in [national projects](#), [training](#) in the medical facilities of our partners, and [objective and structured assessment](#).

## Research

We are utilizing our [central research facilities](#) at Delta University to tackle the most common diseases in our society. We focus on obesity, diabetes, new technology in diagnosis and therapy diseases, artificial intelligence in medicine, urban medicine and public health. We approach our research using inter- and transdisciplinary approach involving decision makers and stakeholders throughout the whole research process.



### Goal 3: Ensure healthy lives and promote well-being for all at all ages

We cannot tackle complex problems in healthcare alone, especially in this era where many environmental and social factors have significant impact on our health and wellbeing. By working with local authorities in health sector such as [health directorate](#) in Dakahlia governorate, we can help communities who are in most needs with free medical examination and free medications. In addition, we established national collaboration with different [universities](#) and [hospitals](#) to develop the skills of our students in health profession. The collaboration with charitable NGO's in health sector such as [Baheya Foundation](#) and [Egyptian Red Crescent](#), etc. is essential for sharing information and knowledge. In 2022, we signed cooperation agreement with two international universities; Open University Malaysia (OUM) and UCSI University to promote student transfer and intercultural knowledge related to health problems.





Ensure inclusive and equitable quality education and promote lifelong learning opportunities for all

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### Strategy and Objectives

Sustainability education is the process of imparting information, skills, and values to students so that they can identify and constructively respond to the interconnected social, economic, and environmental problems that threaten our planet. It encompasses a holistic approach that promotes critical thinking, creativity, and problem-solving abilities to foster sustainable development and a more equitable future for mankind.

Delta University for Science and Technology endeavored to adopt the sustainability goals throughout its nine faculties. We do that using different approaches:

- (1) Integrating United Nation's SDG targets into existing curricula.
- (2) Experiential learning methods, such as field trips and hands-on projects centered on real-life problems.
- (3) Collaborative learning and interdisciplinary approaches.

We enable our students to become active participants in sustainability initiatives and encourages them to take responsibility for their actions and decisions.

### Awareness campaigns



We raise awareness of the challenges that we face in Egypt and we shed the light on the national policies and governmental initiatives to tackle these challenges through field trips and training with stakeholders.

Our students visited the national projects to achieve Egypt's vision 2030 such as new capital city. They also develop their vocational skills by visiting industry related to their career and participating in the annual Job fair on campus. We also organize graduate student summit and training programs to enhance the interaction between our students and alumni.



We organized more than **30 face-to-face workshops** and **50 webinars** in 2022 for all university community including staff, students and employees to show how SDGs can be incorporated in faculty's curricula, teaching strategy and student activities. We foresaw the paradigm shift in higher education and scientific research in Egypt with a new strategy which was launched on 7 March, 2023 to shift the educational, research and community services goals of all Egyptian universities toward sustainability by fulfilling its seven pillars.

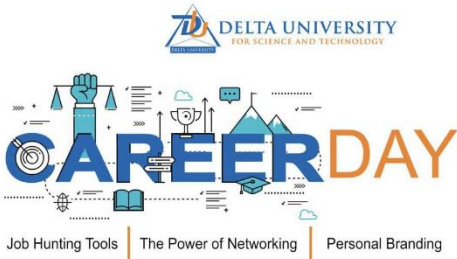




**Community Outreach**

Community Education and Outreach programs at Delta University aim to provide resources and services to people who may lack access to them. [School](#) and [orphanages](#) outreach, [adult literacy](#) and [alumni reunion](#) programs are amongst the highest priority activity of community service council and sustainability community annual plans. Delta University is committed to engage with young generation of school students either by inviting them on campus to see real university life or by visiting them in their schools. The university seeks to inspire and motivate young people and recognize them as active citizens in our community. The university also educate them with modern technology facilities, show them how we can do scientific research in simple and interactive way. We want to acknowledge young generation as competent learners, and build active communities of engagement and inquiry.



We work with our partners in [the General Authority for Adult Education](#) to measure and eradicate literacy among the workers in the university and in the villages located in Dakahlia governorate. We started the first phase in 2022 by [raising awareness](#) inside the university, [measuring adult literacy rates](#) during our medical conveys to the villages and starting the implementation plan with our partners.

We seek to build a strong relationship with our graduates, providing them with the [necessary skills](#) for labour market and inviting them into [reunion events](#).

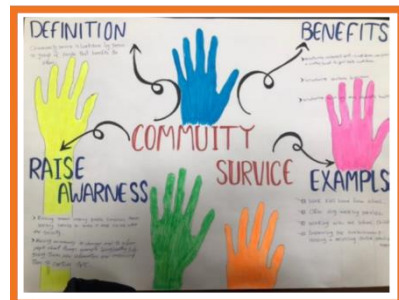

To stop violence against women, we organized several events in 2022 in collaboration with [general secretariat mental health and addiction treatment and Safe institution \(NOG\)](#).

To promote high quality education for our students, we are signing collaboration agreements with NGO's, industry, stakeholders and educational companies such as [Investors Association](#), [Egypt Exchange](#), [Adult Education authority](#), [British Council](#), [HP LIFE](#), [Coursera](#), [Industrial Area](#).

We also collaborate with international universities such as [Plymouth University](#), [University of Oradea](#), [Hong Kong University](#), [Synergy University](#), [JCSI University](#), [Open University Malaysia](#) to promote dual degrees, student and staff exchange, and research collaboration in thematic related to real life problems.

To tackle hunger in local community, the chairman of the board of trustees of Delta University announced in his annual reward for research that he will provide funding for research projects that lead to enhancement of the production [high quality wheat and rice](#) in collaboration with the ministry of agriculture and he introduced a new reward for agriculture research for year 2023.

### Students Life

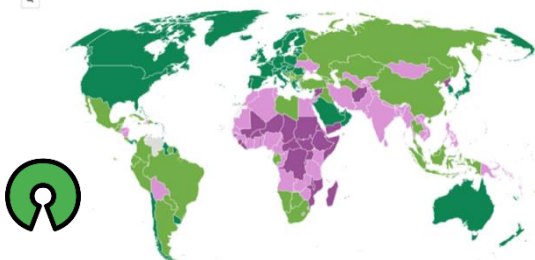


## Research

We believe that building research collaboration with researchers from low and lower-middle income countries is essential for sustainable development and intercultural learning. We have more than 200 publications with authors from countries with low resources in the subject areas of engineering and technology, computer science, life science, medicine and physical science. We have a bylaw in place to reward researchers from Delta University when they publish with those countries and we offer also support their research proposal funding.
